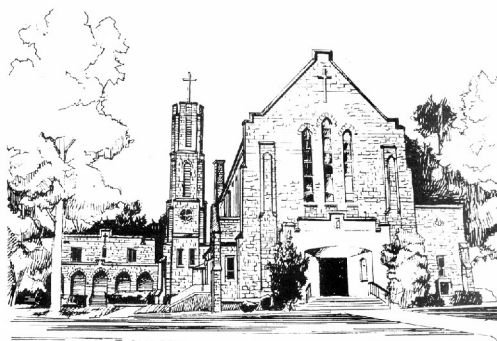


ST. JOSEPH CATHOLIC CHURCH ADULT EDUCATION SESSIONS - 2009-10

HISTORY OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH: Roger Iacovoni

26 sessions beginning September 9 until May 2010.

The Church History class is open to new participants. The course consists of the history of the Church with a strong emphasis on apologetics. The second semester will begin with a study of Constantine the Great (c. A.D. 313) and the Church's emergence from the shadows as a recognized and legal religion within the Roman Empire. We will be covering the Arian Heresy, some of the early Church Fathers and Popes, as well as the impact that the Catholic Church had on the development of Western Civilization.

The textbook for the fall semester will also be used in the spring. *The textbook is Triumph: The Power and the Glory of the Catholic Church and will be provided.*

A STUDY OF THE BOOK OF HEBREWS: Malcolm and Gwen Skipper

9 sessions beginning January 6

This study will highlight the letter to the Hebrews, the Jewish Christians. It is a message of encouragement which calls to 21st-century readers. The key focus is on Jesus Christ and His superiority to all heavenly beings and human leaders. Its emphasis on faith in what cannot be seen and its insistence that covenants and contracts really matter are all critical issues of faith today. Mindful of our concerns about the dangers and challenges of our present-day culture, we can learn much from Hebrews. *The textbook is the Collegeville Bible Commentary on Hebrews and will be provided.*
