

# Renovations

## Stained Glass Windows

- Old exterior protective coverings removed and disposed
- Windows strengthen and waterproofed
- Windows cleaned, repaired, and broken pieces of stained glass replaced
- Exterior protective covering installed

## Electrical

- Removed and replaced original wiring (from 1948)

## Sound

- All new speakers in the Church
- New cordless microphones
- New assistive listening devices for the hearing impaired
- New speakers for cry room, sacristy and choir loft

## Sanctuary

- Painted *Biscuit*
- Painted niches and under arches *Bagel*
- Painted St. Joseph and Blessed Mother Chapels *Interactive Cream*
- New custom designed tabernacle from Madrid, Spain
- Previous tabernacle relocated and used as a repository for the Holy Oils
- New dome ceiling and lighting
- Marble of the Reredos professionally cleaned and polished
- Holy Rood Group (crucifix) and angels professionally cleaned and polished
- New lights within the Reredos to illuminate the Crucifix
- New accent lighting behind the Reredos and Crucifix
- New curtain (liturgical design fabric) installed behind the Reredos
- Niches in the sanctuary framed with artistic woodwork to conceal air ducts
- Statues professionally cleaned and polished
- Sections of the original altar rail installed in front of the statues
- New light system to enable light patterns for different liturgies and occasions
- New spotlights
- New altar vases
- New censer and boat
- Mass bell tassel replaced

## Nave

- Painted *Interactive Cream*
- Statue of Francis de Sales (arriving Spring 2010)
- Plaster finials on each of the pillars faux painted with an antiqued brass appearance
- Plaster pillars extending to the ceiling faux painted with wood finish
- Corbels under choir loft painted faux wood finish with decorative faux plaster fixtures (late Fall)
- Arches in the nave decorated with artistic molding and center rosettes

#### Nave (continued)

- Second Mass bell and tassel installed in the back
- St. Vincent de Paul poor boxes replaced with wall mounted, tamper-proof metal boxes
- Wooden crosses above the Stations cleaned and repainted
- Lower molding around columns re-stained
- New higher molding added around columns
- New molding on the confessionals
- Upgraded pendant lights
- New lights on the beams
- New lights in the Sacred Heart and the Blessed Mother niches
- New emergency lighting in case of power outage
- New powered door openers for those with mobility challenges

#### Vestibule/Narthex

- Painted *Interactive Cream*
- Portraits of the Pope and the Bishop of Charleston mounted
- New light fixtures for narthex (arriving late October)
- New Papal and American Flag sets
- Memorial plaques refinished

#### Choir Loft

- Painted *Interactive Cream*
- New Allen electronic organ (due to extensive damage/ high cost to repair Moeller pipe organ)
  - Pipe Organ campaign will begin soon
  - Note: existing pipes will be retained
- New lighting
- New floor
- Closets removed
- Safety walls added

#### Sacred and Work Sacristies

- Painted *Interactive Cream*
- Cabinets replaced and upgraded
- New granite countertops on the cabinets and center island
- New sacrarium
- New refrigerator
- New floors
- Closet painted, shelves added
- New roof for Work Sacristy
- New ceiling for Work Sacristy

#### Cry Room

- Painted *Interactive Cream*
- New sound proof glass between the cry room and sanctuary
- New floor
- Changing table added to restroom (arriving late October)

#### Parish House - Ministries Room/Kitchen/Media Room

(This area has been redesigned for small bereavement meals, brides, meetings, etc. – effective November 1.)

- New floor
- New rugs
- Replaced dining table/chairs
- Furniture re-upholstered

#### Adoration Chapel

- Painted *Interactive Cream*
- Altar installed
- New Thabor for Monstrance
