

THE SEVEN SUNDAYS OF ST. JOSEPH STARTING FEBRUARY 1, 2026

The Seven Sundays of St. Joseph is a devotion to the patron of the universal Church. It is related that a ship containing a number of passengers was wrecked off the coast of Holland. Two Franciscan monks, who had clung to a plank for two days, were saved by a man of venerable appearance who miraculously brought them to shore. Upon their asking him who he was, he replied, "I am Joseph, and I desire you to honor my seven sorrows and seven joys." This was the origin of the devotion of

the seven sorrows and seven joys of St. Joseph. On the seven Sundays preceding his feast, March 19, the faithful have traditionally contemplated a series of circumstances—seven sorrows and joys—in his life so that they might confront the joys and sorrows of their own lives as he did. The Seven Sundays in honor of St. Joseph are observed in the following manner: Holy Communion is received in his honor on seven consecutive Sundays, and on each Sunday, the prayers in honor of the

Seven Sorrows and Seven Joys of St. Joseph are recited. Every Saturday at 12 PM, starting on January 31, we will be posting the reflection for the upcoming Sunday on our Facebook page. 

Scholarship Opportunities at St. Joseph's

Luker-Meyer Scholarship

For St. Joseph students

In honor of Dr. and Mrs. Luker's parents, Norman, Shirley, Merlin, and Lois, this annual scholarship fund of \$25,000.00 will provide up to 50% scholarships for children from our parish. The purpose of the Luker-Meyer Scholarships is to help parish families with children to have the opportunity of a Catholic education.

The scholarship is intended to follow the individual child through their time at St. Joseph School. The scholarship is renewable as long as the child continues to demonstrate satisfactory academic performance and the family qualifies through FACTS and fulfills the requirements outlined below.

Families must be practicing Catholics, active members at Saint Joseph Church and fulfill the need qualification. To demonstrate need, families must first complete the FACTS process. Families must also complete the Tuition Parishioner Discount agreement.

Recipients are required to join Msgr. Harris and Dr. and Mrs. Luker for a beginning-of-school-year luncheon.

Ranson-Able Scholarship

For St. Joseph students

In memory of William (Bill) F. Ranson III, Ph.D., a Professor of Mechanical Engineering, who valued education, and an early Catholic education in particular, as a foundation for the development of moral and ethical values and academic strengths. This annual scholarship will offer up to 50% in scholarships to eligible students of St. Joseph Catholic School, offering families with limited means the opportunity for a Catholic education.

This is a scholarship for the 2026-2027 academic year. Applications may be submitted for students 4K through 6th grade attending St. Joseph School. Families must be actively practicing Catholics, must be registered and regularly contributing members of St. Joseph Church and fulfill the need qualification. To demonstrate need, families must first complete the FACTS process. Families must also complete the Tuition Parishioner Discount Agreement. Applicants may apply yearly as receiving this scholarship in one year does not preclude receiving it another year.

Laurie, Heather, and Alex Wier
Saint Joseph Mental Health Awareness Scholarship

For students who are currently in 5th, 6th, or 7th grade - and who will be entering 6th, 7th, or 8th grade at St. Joseph or CN - are eligible to apply.

The Laurie, Heather and Alex Wier Saint Joseph Mental Health Awareness Scholarship awards two \$2,500 scholarships - one to a boy and one to a girl - for students who are currently in 5th, 6th, or 7th grade - and who will be entering 6th, 7th, or 8th grade at St. Joseph or Cardinal Newman in the upcoming academic year. Designed to help offset tuition costs, the scholarship also aims to promote open conversations about mental health and reduce the stigma often surrounding it.

Applicants are asked to submit an essay focusing on one mental health topic relevant to adolescents, such as:

- Eating Disorders
- Anxiety Disorders
- Depression
- Substance Abuse
- Self-Harm or Suicidal Thoughts
- ADHD (Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder)
- Social Media Impact
- Bipolar Disorder
- Schizophrenia

Through thoughtful reflection and awareness, the scholarship encourages students to develop empathy, understanding, and a willingness to speak openly about mental health challenges affecting today's youth.
