Upcoming Second Collections August 8-9 - Disaster Assistance

Funds raised will provide relief to South Carolina communities and parishes affected by hurricanes and other natural disasters. Your generosity will help meet immediate needs and support recovery efforts for those impacted by these events.



Since opening the doors of its first location in 2021, St. Clare's Home has served more than 80 mothers, welcomed more than 40 babies into the world and provided shelter, safety and security to more than 30 children. This September, Charleston communities have a chance to continue the momentum of this good work.

The second annual Charleston Pink & Blue Gala is set for Sept. 26, 2026, at 6 p.m. It will be held at the Charleston Marriott Hotel. The evening will include silent and live auctions, and the ever-popular Heads or Tails game, with a chance to win a Sunset Cruise in the Charleston Harbor.

The St. Clare's Home is a space for expectant mothers who choose life and need shelter, safety and security. The Pink & Blue Gala is the homes' foundational event to raise vital funds needed for the operational costs of the mission to serve women in crisis. This year, a portion of the gala funds will be earmarked for the construction of a convent for the Hospitaller Sisters of Mercy, who staff the home. Building this convent will increase the home's capacity and allow two additional women to live there and work toward sustaining themselves and their children independently.

"For the past year, the Hospitaller Sisters of Mercy have been graciously living alongside our residents," said Valerie Baronkin, executive director. "While this has been a beautiful season of shared community, funds will be raised at this year's Charleston Gala for the construction of their convent. Having their own convent will finally provide the sisters with a proper, independent living space so they can continue their vital ministry with strength and comfort."
