

HEARING LOOP IN THE SANCTUARY:

In order to access the Loop, a hearing aid must be programmed for the "T" setting, which can be done by a hearing aid specialist. When in the Church, the user can go to the "T" setting on their device and will be connected to the speaker system via their hearing aid.

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ, On the weekend of Nov. 16-17, our diocese will take up the national collection for the Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD).

Your support for this collection brings change to communities across the country and our state. It empowers those living in poverty to gain stability in their lives, spiritually as well as financially.

One of the principles that has made CCHD successful at reaching people on the margins for more than 50 years is its support for community-based solutions rather than uniform, top-down programs that do not account for local needs or include local voices.

In South Carolina, this would affect our more rural regions, especially those families that do not have access to the resources, job opportunities and education to break the cycles of poverty.

All CCHD national grants are approved by the bishop in the (arch)diocese where the funded groups operate. When you give to this campaign, 25% of your contribution stays in the Diocese of Charleston to help continue the successful work of reaching those on the margins.


