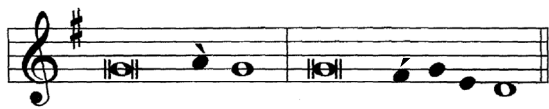
## Liturgy of the Word

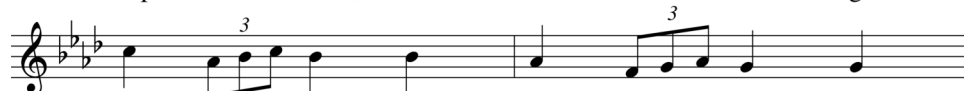
