- Seating — The seating capacity is only 400 in the church. Priority will be given to families of ordinands, priests and deacons, and those who need assistance. Overflow will be in the gym with a simulcast shown on a large screen. The gym will seat over 500 people. Please note that due to limited seating, you may need to attend in the overflow area.

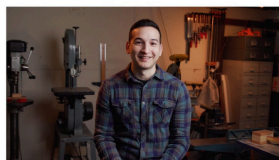

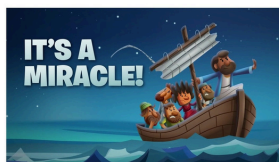
