

# POSITION OPENINGS AT ST. JOSEPH CHURCH ORGANIST

St. Joseph Church is seeking an experienced organist. This position would report directly to the Director of Music. The organist is the main organist of the parish and is responsible for the execution of all organ music, including preludes, offertories, and postludes, as determined by the organist in collaboration with the Director of Music and Pastor, when necessary. The commitment is for all Saturday and Sunday masses (currently 5:30 PM Saturday, and 8:00 AM, 10:30 AM, and 12:15 PM on Sunday), as well as Ash Wednesday, The Pascal Triduum, The Great Easter Vigil, extra Christmas and Easter Masses, Ordination, Rite of Election, All Saints, All Souls, First Communion, May Processional, New Year's Eve, New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day Mass, Mass of Assumption, and any other masses that may be scheduled. Candidates must have knowledge of and keep current on trends and directions of sacred church music in the Catholic church to assure all music used in liturgical services and special activities is appropriate in accordance with the church traditions as well as current practices and dictates of Church authorities. The organist position is a 30 hour per week position, salaried with benefits for 12 months per year. Biweekly compensation is paid to the organist.

## DIRECTOR OF MAINTENANCE

St. Joseph Church is seeking an experienced maintenance person for the Director of Maintenance. This position would start as Asst. Director for the first eighteen months, while training under the current Director of Maintenance. This transition is part of the position due to the complexity of the position. Under the direction of the Pastor and Business Manager, this position is responsible for maintaining the buildings, grounds and equipment of St. Joseph Church, including but not limited to the church, the school, the school recreation spaces, the office building, the rectory, the Blossom House, Columbarium and parking lots. The position is responsible for physically working on assets as well as negotiating contracts with service providers, inspecting facilities to meet standards and regulations, and coordinating renovations and updates. Candidates must have knowledge of heating and cooling systems, plumbing, electrical wiring, property maintenance, and property improvement. Candidates must be able to move items, use ladders, and meet the physical demands of such a position.

## Spotting a scam:

Scammers use casual, brief messages urging help or aid. Texts have non-local numbers; emails use fake addresses mimicking real ones. Check sender email addresses for phoniness, resembling but differing slightly from authentic ones (e.g., FrJoe@gmail.com vs. FrJoe@msn.com).

## Precautions:

- Respond to money-related texts/emails in person/phone to verify legitimacy.
- Don't click on any part of these messages; they might contain malicious software.
- Avoid sharing passwords or opening infected email attachments.
- Scammers create urgency or curiosity to manipulate emotions.
- Be wary of urgent demands, requests to bypass policies, or offers that seem too good to be true (like winning a lottery).

Our church primarily communicates through weekly electronic updates (via Flocknote) and mail.


