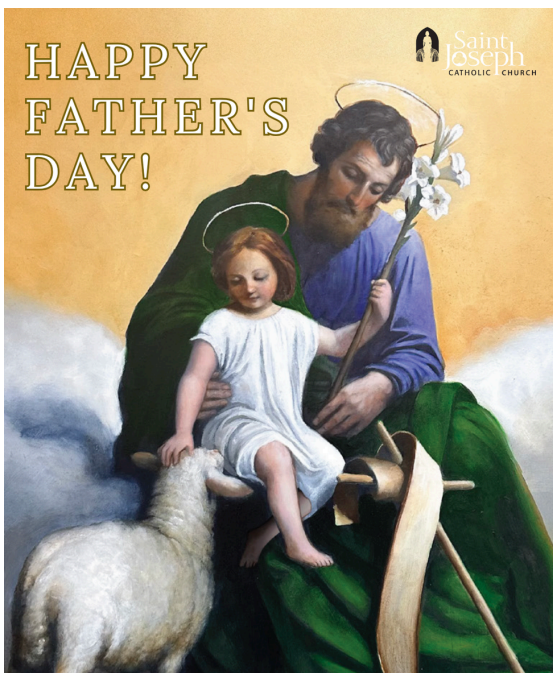

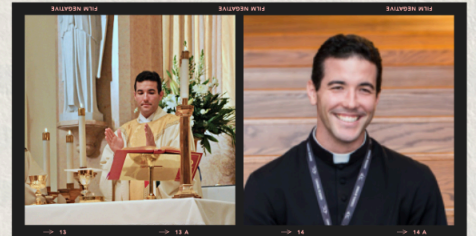

WELCOME FATHER LACOMBE

WELCOME OUR NEW PAROCHIAL VICAR: REV. PAUL R. LACOMBE



We are delighted to welcome Fr. Paul R. Lacombe to St. Joseph Catholic Church as our new Parochial Vicar beginning July 5th. He was ordained on June 9, 2023, and has already served in a variety of parish and campus ministry roles. A priest of the Diocese of Charleston, Fr. Lacombe currently serves at the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist and Sacred Heart Church, and as chaplain to the College of Charleston.

Fr. Lacombe was born and raised in Beaufort, South Carolina, where he grew up at St. Peter's Parish. Remarkably, he says he has been thinking about becoming a priest since the age of five. In speaking about his vocation, Fr. Lacombe points to his favorite Scripture passage, John 3:30: "He must increase; I must decrease." He explains, "That really captures what a priest is supposed to do and be—someone who represents Christ for others, living with humility so that God may be more present."

Fr. Lacombe is especially excited to serve at St. Joseph, sharing, "I'm really excited to have the opportunity to minister under Msgr. Harris. He has a wealth of knowledge, and I'm looking forward to learning from him." He also looks forward to getting to know the parish, particularly since this will be his first extended time ministering in Columbia. "There's something really good already happening at St. Joseph, and I want to enter into that," he says.

He also shared a small and meaningful connection with Msgr. Harris that brings a smile: when Msgr. Harris celebrated Midnight Mass at St. Anthony's in Walterboro shortly after his ordination, Fr. Lacombe was actually there, as a one-year-old child, likely the baby crying while his mother waited in the confessional trying to keep him quiet. "It's a funny connection," he laughs, "but also a sign of grace."

Fr. Lacombe has a deep appreciation for the teaching of Vatican II, especially regarding the role of the laity in the Church. "The lay faithful aren't just a part of the Church, they are a real way the Church lives and breathes in the world," he shares. "So many people are quietly living their vocations, doing acts of service out of love for Christ. My role as a priest is to encourage and guide, helping people come together in faith." When it comes to connecting with others, Fr. Lacombe emphasizes empathy. "It's so important to understand where someone is coming from and meet them there," he says. He enjoys spending time simply being present with people—whether that's with friends, family, or parishioners. In his free time, he enjoys kayaking and walking whenever he can.

Asked a few lighter questions, Fr. Lacombe shares: "I'm definitely more of a night owl, and I do enjoy a good cup of coffee." As for comfort food, "macaroni and cheese is hard to beat, and I really enjoy a good piece of baked chicken." If given the chance to travel, he would love to visit Paris, where his family traces its roots.

As he begins his ministry here, Fr. Lacombe has a simple and heartfelt request: "If the parish would be willing to pray for me, that I may be a holy priest, I would be very grateful."

Please join us in warmly welcoming Fr. Lacombe to St. Joseph and keeping him in your prayers as he begins this new chapter of ministry among us.
