The ability to match pitch and basic music literacy is required. Schola cantorum rehearses on Wednesday nights (6-7:30) and sing weekly at the Sunday morning 10:30 AM Mass. St. Joseph's Parish has a rich history of choral literature preparing sacred choral works and Gregorian chant for weekly Masses. The choir has toured and performed all over the world, including for the Papal Mass in Columbia in 1987.

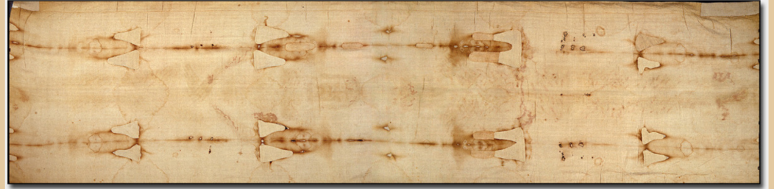

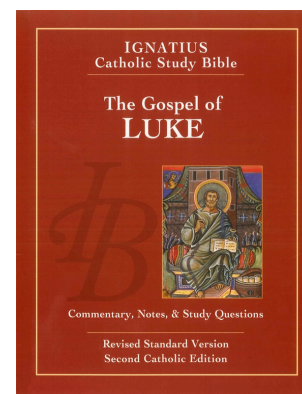
