



Dear Saint Joseph Parishioners,

With heartfelt gratitude to you, our committed parishioners, we are happy to report that our mortgage on the Ministries and Administration Building has been satisfied. As a parish, we were able to attain over 100% of our parish goal. On January 31st we will no longer be collecting Capital Campaign funds via electronic funds transfers (EFTs) and that portion of our electronic giving will be disabled.





Consecration to St. Joseph



In 2020, the Catholic Church celebrates the 150th Anniversary of St. Joseph being named Patron of the Universal Church by Pope Pius IX. Drawing on the wealth of the Church's living tradition, Fr. Donald Calloway, MIC, calls on all of us to turn to St. Joseph and entrust ourselves, our Church, our families, and our world to our spiritual father's loving care, and then watch for wonders when the Universal Patron of the Church opens the floodgates of Heaven to pour out graces into our lives today. Definitely a book for our time, **Consecration to St. Joseph** is dedicated to meeting the challenges of the present moment and restoring order to our Church and our world, all through the potent paternal intercession and care of St. Joseph. This book has everything you need to take your love and devotion to St. Joseph; and prayers and devotions to St. Joseph.

Consecration to St. Joseph emulates the tried-and-true preparation method employed by St. Louis de Montfort in his Marian consecration, highlighting many of St. Joseph's titles, privileges, and heroic virtues. The program of preparation and consecration takes 33 days. What does it mean for a person to be consecrated to St. Joseph? It basically means that you entrust yourself entirely into his paternal care so that he can help you acquire his virtues and become holy. Total consecration to St. Joseph means you make a formal act of filial entrustment to your spiritual father so that he can take care of your spiritual well-being and lead you to God. The person who consecrates himself to St. Joseph wants to be as close to his spiritual father as possible, to the point of resembling him in virtue and holiness. Saint Joseph, in turn, will give those consecrated to him his undivided attention, protection, and guidance. "Ite Ad Joseph" – "Go to Joseph."
