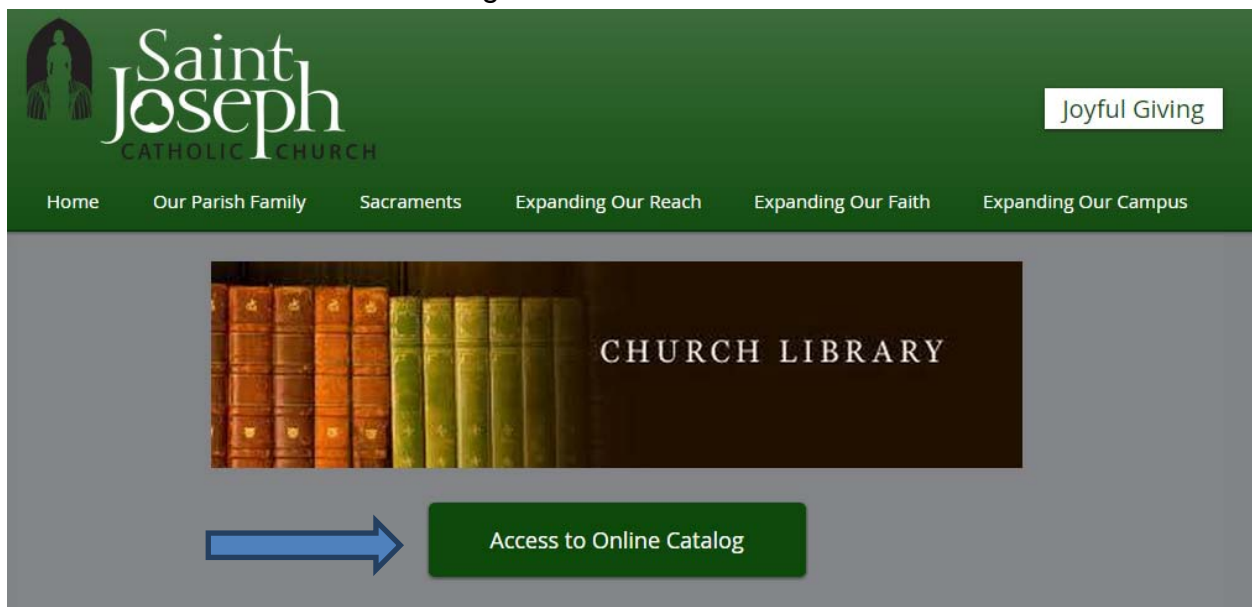


## HOW TO REQUEST A BOOK

1. You must be a registered Library user. If you have not registered, please fill out the St. Joseph Church Library Borrower application and return it to either the Church Library or the Church office.
2. Go to the Saint Joseph Church website – [www.stjosephcolumbia.org](http://www.stjosephcolumbia.org)
3. Place the cursor over “Our Parish Family”. Then click on “Parish Library”.



4. Click on “Access to Online Catalog”



5. Put in a search term and click on “title search”, “author search”, or “keyword search”.
