

HEARING LOOP IN THE SANCTUARY:

In order to access the Loop, a hearing aid must be programmed for the "T" setting, which can be done by a hearing aid specialist. When in the Church, the user can go to the "T" setting on their device and will be connected to the speaker system via their hearing aid.

# EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP TRUST FUND (ESTF) IS NOW AVAILABLE

We are excited to share that the Education Scholarship Trust Fund (ESTF) is now available once again — opening doors for more families to access a high-quality Catholic education in our diocese.

The scholarship amount has increased to \$7,500 per student, and prior enrollment in a public school is no longer a requirement — making the program far more accessible.

Highlights

- Scholarship Amount: \$7,500/year per student
- Eligibility: Household income must be at or below 300% of the 2025 Federal Poverty Guideline
- Application Start Date:
  - Military Families: Early access began May 12
  - All Families: Applications open May 19


