HEARING LOOP IN THE SANCTUARY:

In order to access the Loop, a hearing aid must be programmed for the "T" setting, which can be done by a hearing aid specialist. When in the Church, the user can go to the "T" setting on their device and will be connected to the speaker system via their hearing aid.

GETTING TO KNOW OUR ST. JOSEPH CANTORS

The word cantor is from mid-16th century Latin canere 'to sing'. In the earliest days of the church this person was called the psalmist and it was always a young boy. In fact, before one could be ordained to the priesthood, he must have served as a psalmist, something of a rite of passage to the priesthood.

Currently, there are six active St. Joseph cantors: Thomas Blake, Curran Bramhall, Dr. Michael Dickson, Semaj Digby, Kate Maroney, and Briona Robinson. St. Joseph cantors are responsible to sing the Introit before the opening hymn, lead the singing of the Kyrie, sing the verses of the Responsorial Psalm and Gospel Acclamation, and the antiphons during the preparation of the gifts and at communion.

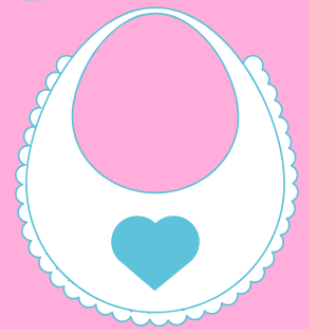
