St Joseph Catholic Church is hiring basketball gym supervisors for our church basketball league starting October 17, 2022 through February 9, 2023. Our gym will be open Mondays through Thursday, 4:30 - 9:30 PM and Fridays, 4:30 - 7:30 pm. Applicants may apply for one to five days of the week. There will be no gym time 11/22 - 11/25 for Thanksgiving, or 12/14 - 1/2 for Christmas. Responsibilities include supervision of gym, ensuring equipment is functional (balls and hoops), lowering and raising the hoops as needed for teams, checking teams in, assisting with questions, ensuring the gym is cleaned up after use, locking up and setting up chairs after Friday practices. 


