FRAUD ALERT: BEWARE OF IMPERSONATION AND PAYMENT SCAMS

We have recently seen an increase in email, text, and QR code scams impersonating parish priests and staff. Please be aware that St. Joseph clergy and staff will never request donations, gift cards, financial assistance, or payments through email, text messages, Venmo, PayPal, or QR codes.

Protect Yourself:

- Do not click links, scan QR codes, or open attachments from suspicious messages.
- Check email addresses and phone numbers carefully—scammers often use addresses that appear legitimate.
- Our email addresses always end in [@stjosephcolumbia.org](mailto:info@stjosephcolumbia.org) (for example: info@stjosephcolumbia.org)
- Be cautious of PayPal or Venmo QR codes shared through emails, texts, or social media posts claiming to represent the parish.
- Beware of scammers using fake identities who may send money to your Venmo account "by mistake" and then ask you to return the funds. The original payment may later be reversed, leaving you responsible for the amount sent.
- Verify any financial request by calling the parish office.
- Be wary of messages that create urgency or pressure you to act immediately.
